Modifications are allowed that fit into the "spirit" of the respective time or correspond to the technical status of the approved re-releases. Controller and batteries (up to 7.4V) are free. Tires, rims, shock absorbers and gears are free. Brushless + brushed motors are permitted.	
	For all 2WD classes max. 13.5 brushless or 14T brushed motors. 2WD mid-engine is only allowed if this was intended according to the original assembly instructions. Homemade 2WD mid-engine buggies (1977 – 1993) can start in the 2WD MID class.	
	With 2WD Truck, the motor rules of 2WD Buggy also apply.	
	For all 4WD classes max.: 10.5 brushless or 12T brushed motors.	
	2WD + 4WD Torque-Tuned classes: Tamiya Torque Tuned standard engine in standard condition, gear ratio is free. All vehicles (1977 - 1993) must use at least the standard plastic or aluminum chassis and the standard lower wishbones. Carbon fiber chassis and big-bore shock absorbers are not permitted. The Top-Force and Top-Force Evolution are also allowed to start if they are equipped with the Manta-Ray tub chassis.
